



## IMPORTANT TURF INFORMATION

Please Keep in Your Equipment Bag for Reference

### ANDY LIVINGSTONE

- All goals must be chained and locked after the last game of the day
- The lock combination to the goalie is 4368 (West) and 5981 (East): dial the number then press the shackle (depress the hook into the lock and push it together); to re-lock, scramble the number. **Do not leave this lock unlocked**, even between games.
- Changing room access codes are:
  - West/women: 2 + 3 at the same time, then 4, then 5
  - East/men: 3 + 4 at the same time, then 2, then 1

*All Andy Livingstone Field users rely on each other and should understand the following:*

  - *The changing room combination should be kept 'need to know' only*
  - *Once the door is left open or the combination is compromised, so is the condition, security, and safety of the changing rooms*
  - *Do not allow access to anyone you do not know personally or is not associated with your group*
  - *VPB recommends that those accessing the change rooms should be supervised and to not do so alone*
  - *Do not leave the changing room doors open/propped open for convenience*
  - *Do not leave valuables in the change rooms or consider the area safe/secure*
  - *Keep in mind that tother field users utilise the change rooms, have the user code, and have a vested interest in its condition and function*
  - *Do not shout the access code across the field*

### COQUITLAM

- All goals must be moved back to the fence and daisy chained at the end of the last game of the day
- Lights are on an automatic timer. **Any problems, look for the on-site City of Coquitlam fields person. You can try calling the field rep on duty at 604.506.4965**

### CROFTON

- Absolutely no dogs are permitted at the field
- No soccer cleats
- The button to turn on the water is on the right side of the big door of the field house (West half of the field). Note: the watering system must be turned 'on' from inside (by Crofton) before the switch will work from the outside.
- All goals have to be moved back to the concrete area at the end of the last game of the day



## HAMBER

- Absolutely no dogs are permitted at the field
- No soccer cleats
- **At no time may a vehicle be parked/stopped in the emergency vehicle access to Hamber Field** (including the grass verge). Remember that emergency vehicles include first responder fire trucks which need all available space. **Umpires should regard playing conditions as unsafe** if a car is blocking the entrance and should not start the game. Or, if the game is underway and a car moves into the prohibited space, they should immediately stop the game. In both situations, call the team captains into conference and explain why the game is not started/stopped. It is not the umpires' responsibility to search for the car's owner.

## MINORU

- No dogs are permitted at the field
- No food and drinks (except water) are permitted at the field
- (At Minoru) Goals must be moved from the gated fence before the game and back to the gated fence at the end of the game
- (At Cambie) Goals have to be moved from the side of the field before the game and returned to the side of the field after the game

## RUTLEDGE

- No soccer cleats
- Use the boot brushes prior to entry onto the turf to avoid grass being tracked onto the field

## TAMANAWIS

- No soccer cleats
- To activate the lights:
  - Step 1: enter 5 digit PIN (50500)
  - Step 2: Press 1 for the lights on the new field OR Press 2 for the lights on the old field
  - Step 3: Press #
- To deactivate lights: repeat steps 1 and 2, followed by \*
- Change room code: 4229\* (Do not leave valuables in the change room)

## WRIGHT FIELD

- The grey start button to activate the water cannons is on the East side of the pitch between the benches, inside the grey metal box
