### Young Players



- We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game.
- As a player you have a big part of that game.
- That's why Field Hockey BC is asking every player to follow a Respect Codes of Conduct.

When playing Field Hockey, I will:

- Always play to the best of my ability.
  - Play fairly – I won't cheat, complain or waste time.
  - Adhere to the laws and spirit of the game.
  - Respect my team-mates, the other team, the umpire/official or my coach/manager.
  - Play by the rules, as directed by the umpire/official.
  - Shake hands with the other team and umpire at the end of the game.
  - Listen and respond to what my coach/team manager tells me
  - Talk to someone I trust if I am unhappy about anything at my club or field hockey program
- I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by my club, league, or Provincial Association:

I may be:

- Issued with a verbal warning from a club, league, or Provincial official
- Required to meet with the club, league or Provincial committee.
- Requested to undertake an education course.
- Required to leave the match venue by the club, league, host, or Provincial Association.
- Requested by the club not to attend future games.
- Suspended or have my club membership removed.
- Required to leave the club along with any dependents. In addition:
- The club, league, or Provincial Association could impose a fine and/or suspension on the club
